

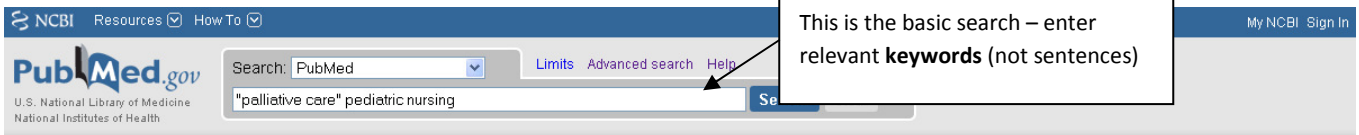
PubMed is a freely available database maintained by the National Library of Medicine in the United States. It comprises more than 20 million citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE, life science journals, and online books. Citations may include links to full-text content from PubMed Central and publisher web sites.

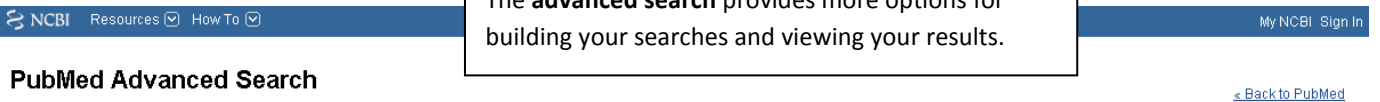

Specialty searches limit to a type of publication (e.g. clinical trials) or to types of subject heading common to all medical databases (e.g. MeSH headings).

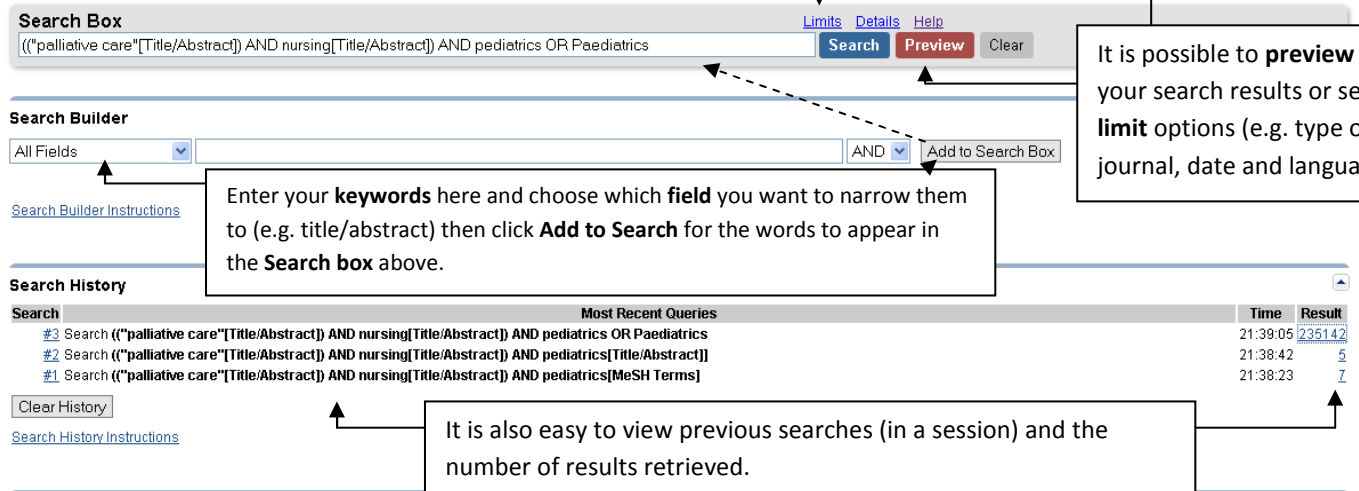
Search this database: Advanced Search

Enter your **keywords** here and choose which **field** you want to narrow them to (e.g. title/abstract) then click **Add to Search** for the words to appear in the **Search box** above.

It is also easy to view previous searches (in a session) and the number of results retrieved.
